Every child who gets 100% for the next half term will win an Easter Egg! Currently attendance is sitting at 91% and




## **Key School Improvement News:**

Top scores this week are from Shae, Matty, Leo and Charlie from Adventure Team; and from Sahara in Fairytale 2. Well done.






#### This week's BOOK RECOMMENDATION:
