


## **Understanding our assessment scores**





## Throughout school...

Some children perform better or worse in tests than in their daily learning so some scores will not match up. Teachers will always make their own professional judgements based on a wide range of evidence.

For children to be performing at Greater Depth, their scores in our tests need to be at or above 115 consistently.



Scores will probably alter slightly from year-to-year.

A child's score should stay roughly the same each year if they are making expected progress. If it increases by a large amount, this would indicate that the child has made better than expected progress.

## At the end of Year 2 & Year 6

A child must get a score of 100 or more to be classed as Working At Age Related.

Any score above 100 is classed as Working At Age Related. Any score below 100 is classed as not meeting the standard. Any score above 110 is classed as Greater Depth.
